

Dear families,

Please see our school menu from 3rd September 2020 which is on our school website.

We are more than happy for your child to move between hot dinners and packed lunches but please can you let us know <u>as far in advance as possible</u> which days your child/ren would like a hot dinner by replying to this email.

As we are trying to reduce the number of people entering school, money owed can be brought in by your child in the morning and handed straight to the class teacher - <u>this MUST be in a sealed named envelope</u>. Alternatively you can come to the office to pay but please note as we have a one in / one out system you may have to queue outside.

All children in the following classes are entitled to a free school meal everyday:

- reception class
- year 1
- year 2

If you also fall into any of the categories below - please still apply as we can get extra funding which we can use to support your child in many other ways.

Your child (in any other year groups) may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
