Following the Prime Minister's announcement on Monday 4th January; St. Cuthbert's will only reopen to the children of critical workers and vulnerable children on Tuesday 5th January.

Parent/carers of these children are asked to contact the school office, preferably via email, <u>admin@st-cuthbertsrc.northumberland.sch.uk</u> asap to help us plan for their provision.

Online learning will commence for all other pupils from Tuesday 5th January.

We hope to provide as many places for vulnerable pupils and the pupils of key workers as possible but this will depend on staffing safely. Therefore, we would very much appreciate if you only request a place, if your child cannot be cared for safely at home.
